Summary:

Welders, under moderate supervision will lay out, fit and weld fabricated stainless steel and aluminum fixtures and materials. Measures and mark location for metal components utilizing blueprints and drawings. Verifies position metal components in assembly using straight edge, combination square and rule.

Duties & Responsibilities: Essential Job Functions

- Mig, Tig, and Flux Cored welding with ability to read and interpret shop drawings.
- Weld in vertical, flat, horizontal, or overhead positions.
- Use basic hand tools including tape measure, clamps, etc.
- Prep and finish metal components by grinding or sanding.
- Examines work pieces for defects and ensures conformance with specifications.
- Operate material handling equipment. Frequent bending, lifting standing stooping in manufacturing environment.
- Frequent lifting, pushing, pulling up to 75 pounds. Requires sufficient manual dexterity and vision to operated equipment safely.

Education and Experience:

- High School Diploma or equivalent.
- Previous education or minimum of one year welding in metal fab manufacturing environment.
- Experience using shop drawings, fab shop and welding experience.
- Capable of performing standard measurements, good shop math skills and mechanical aptitude.
- Understands basic procedure of voltage and amp settings for given requirements.
- Must be physically able to wear appropriate PPE including welding helmet, gloves, protective apron, safety glasses, and steel toe shoes.

- Ability to bend and stoop frequently
